CGNET's Traveler's Access Service (TAS) increases your productivity on the road by bringing together more than 60,000 connected and wireless access points in more than 160 countries worldwide in one easy-to-use dialer. Users with appropriately configured computers can access dial-up, 802.11 wireless and broadband Ethernet connections. Usage from all over the world is conveniently billed on a consolidated statement, complete with interim notification reporting and pre-determined spending limit settings. There's always a live person at CGNET 24x365 who can provide technical support via telephone, email or instant messaging.

TAS software on the end user's computer stores information on local access points worldwide. End users simply call up the TAS application, choose an appropriate access number, and connect via the preferred networking protocol. End-users don't have to open an account with the local ISP to connect back to their organization's IT resources.

CGNET's TAS is based on the iPass® roaming Internet access service, and is augmented with an additional 60 overseas dialup numbers and more than 1000 domestic numbers to give you greater coverage at the lowest price. TAS charges no setup or monthly user fees. You pay only for the actual time you use.

Security

Secure VPN connections are assured using industry standard products from suppliers such as Cisco, Checkpoint, Nortel, and others. Once integrated, the client's dialer will automatically launch a secure connection from which the user will complete the password logon process for network access. Other security options include:

- Monitored VPN – connection is monitored to ensure the VPN viability. Checking interval can be customized. If the VPN tunnel is down, the session is disconnected.
- Secure Connection – Session will not launch unless the personal firewall is enabled
- Launch on error - personal firewall will automatically be launched if not previously enabled.

Satellite Services

Expanded coverage of CGNET's highly portable Satellite Travelers' Access Service (TAS) is providing global coverage. In addition to being available over more than 85% of the world's land mass, the Broadband Global Area Network (BGAN) service is increasing its bandwidth and adding voice services. Remarkably, the size of the device needed to receive Internet access this way now weighs as little as 1.25 pounds. SAT TAS now is truly the way to get broadband Internet access – and voice – virtually anywhere, no matter how far from power and telecom lines.
